Using Anecdotal Records . Anecdotal records are mere “notes” that you would make quickly following and behavior event. It might be a specific outbreak or tantrum, or it could just as easily be a refusal to do work. In the moment you are busy intervening, but you want to be sure you have a record of the event. Try to keep it objective.
