Use a cleaner that is appropriate for the door surface. Walls/Partitions/Doors and Horizontal Surfaces: Clean walls, partitions, doors and horizontal surfaces with a neutral cleaner and approved disinfectant to remove smudges, spots or graffiti. Wipe dry. Wipe all window ledges with a damp cloth.

CUSTODIAL 4-1. When rinsing a mop in the mop bucket, avoid splashing dirty water or chemical solutions on clothes, hands, or in eyes. Goggles, safety glasses with side shields, or full-face masks should be worn. Mopping puts excess stress on the back, especially if done improperly.

How to Calculate Cleaning Times - ISSA

Use spray bottles filled with Q.T.3 to disinfect surfaces. Disinfectant will be provided daily (or as needed) by custodial services. In rooms with continuous use, the outgoing instructor will spray all desks, seats and other high use touch points utilized by students, instructor or others throughout the class period.

The ISSA Clean Standard: Institutional and Commercial Facilities applies to office buildings, retail stores, hotels, and other similar facilities. It derives from research in K-12 schools, but has been restructured to make it applicable to and easier to use in institutional and commercial facilities.

Washington State University custodial staff will use COVID-19 sanitation guidelines from the Center for Disease Control (CDC) and Washington State Department of Health (DOH) for routine cleaning including common touch surfaces. Please note that increased cleaning in high use locations will result in service reductions or suspensions in low traffic locations, such as private offices.

WSU custodial staff following CDC cleaning recommendations ...

Due to the increased need to disinfect common areas and infected areas, custodial services will clean offices and non-teaching labs by request only. Office trash and recycling should be placed outside the office door on the day/time designated for pick-up by custodial services.
