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## **Reflective Journal Writing Tips for Students**

Journals can be used in conferences to discuss these other writing forms. For example, students could write from the perspective of a personified character, such as an animal or other nonhuman, to personify, research, and learn more about the personified character, and they could write a fictionalized version of a diary.
